held regarding adding the terminology sexual orientation to this

listing as well as changing the word handicap to disability . Pfeifle provided additional

information regarding protective classes.

The proposed changes will read as follows:

(1) No person shall be appointed to or removed from, or in any way favored or discriminated against with respect to any city position or appointive city

administrative office because of race, gender, sexual orientation, age,
disability, religion, country of origin, or political affiliation.

A motion was made by Sue Aguilar and seconded by Pauline Poletes to accept the proposed changes. Thimjon called for a voice vote. All members voted yes. Motion Passed.
