WHEREAS, the City of Sioux Falls intends to place a City-owned bronze sculpture known as Sunday with Jessie by artist Susan Geissler, New York, and selected by citizens as the 2015 SculptureWalk People s Choice Award; and  
WHEREAS, the sculpture depicts a child and dog and measures approximately 32" in height, 13" in width, and 38" in length; and  
WHEREAS, the proposed site placement for the Sunday with Jessie sculpture be prominently displayed on a quartzite pedestal, located at 110 E. 11th St., on the south side of the existing 1st Avenue Parking Ramp; and  
WHEREAS, a future sculpture location is identified in the site design concept plan for the 1st Avenue Parking Ramp Improvements Project and new streetscape for 10th St. and 11th St. corridors. The City of Sioux Falls will be responsible for project costs associated with the sculpture placement and installation; and  
WHEREAS, the Sioux Falls Imagined A Cultural Plan for a Vibrant and Prosperous City, and the Sioux Falls Visual Arts Commission, encourages and recommends the outdoor exhibition of public art in public places within Sioux Falls, SD; and  
WHEREAS, the Sioux Falls Visual Arts Commission reviewed the proposed Sunday with Jessie sculpture and placement on January 17, 2017, and unanimously recommended approval for the sculpture and placement, as presented;
