WHEREAS, on March 7, 2017, the City Council of the City of Sioux Falls adopted Resolution

No. 14-17 to include certain contiguous territory within the corporate limits

of the city of Sioux Falls, SD;

WHEREAS, the annexation map boundaries have been approved by the City Council;

WHEREAS, the legal description as set forth in Resolution 14-17 was not accurate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SIOUX FALLS, SD:

That the legal description as set forth in Resolution 14-17 hereby is amended to read as follows:
