NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SIOUX FALLS, SD:  
That this City Council of democratically elected representatives represent and support all members of the community and condemn acts of hate, violence, or discrimination.
