WHEREAS, Twenty Two Thousand Four Hundred and Three Dollars and No Cents (\$22,403.00) in storm drainage fees were assessed against Parcel No. 54344 for the taxes due in 2010; and

WHEREAS, Twenty Two Thousand Four Hundred and Three Dollars and No Cents (\$22,403.00) in storm drainage fees were assessed against Parcel No. 54344 for the taxes due in 2011; and
