HOWEVER, THE SOUTH DAKOTA SUPREME COURT HAS RULED THAT CITY COUNCILORS MAY NOT ENGAGE IN PRIVATE COMMUNICATIONS WITH PERSONS WHEN THE CITY COUNCIL WILL ACT AS A DECISION-MAKER ON AN UPCOMING MATTER INVOLVING A LICENSE OR A PERMIT. IN THOSE INSTANCES, PERSONS ARE ENCOURAGED TO PROVIDE WRITTEN COMMENTS TO THE ENTIRE CITY COUNCIL OR TO PROVIDE ORAL COMMENT AT THE PUBLIC MEETING ON THAT MATTER WHEN IT IS CONSIDERED BY THE ENTIRE CITY COUNCIL. THOSE WHO PROVIDE COMMENTS SHOULD UNDERSTAND THAT THEIR COMMENTS WILL BECOME PART OF THE OFFICIAL RECORD AND SUBJECT TO REVIEW BY ALL PARTIES AND THE PUBLIC.
